Dear Member,

Effective August 1, 2018, the BCBST Employee Credit Union will no longer send NSF notices, delinquent loan notices, and other notices through inner office mail. All notices will be mailed to the member's address on file or sent via eNotices. If a member does not wish to have Credit Union notices sent to their home address then it is recommended they enroll in eNotices.

Enroll in eNotices by following the instruction below.

- First, log in to Online Banking using your User ID and Password.
- Once logged in, click the "Services" tab from the top navigation bar.
- Next, click the link that says "Sign up for eNotices".
- Then, click the button that says "Start Receiving eNotices".
- You are now enrolled in eNotices! An email will be sent to you each time a notice is generated on your account.

Please note that eNotices will be sent to the email address the system has on file. If you are unsure which email you originally entered or need to change your email, this can be done under the services tab by clicking "Change your Email Address."
